**Main First Uses of Lead and
Zinc in Europe 2017**

Now Available

- This 39 page report continues the International Lead and Zinc Study Group's work, after an eight year intermission, related to the analysis of trends in the main first uses of lead and zinc in Europe.
- Main First Uses of Lead and Zinc in Europe 2017 report was prepared for the Group by the independent UK-based consulting firm Oakdene Hollins. Extensive research that involved direct contact with a broad range of industry experts and associations was carried out in close co-operation with the ILZSG secretariat. Data listed covers the period 2006 to 2015.
- In the case of lead a breakdown of first uses between the categories industrial batteries, automotive batteries, rolled and extruded products, shot and ammunition, cable sheathing, lead compounds (including gasoline additives) and miscellaneous (including alloys) is provided.
- In the case of zinc the breakdown encompasses continuous galvanizing, general galvanizing, brass and bronze, zinc semi-manufactures, zinc alloys, zinc compounds (including dust/powder) and miscellaneous.
